

This "INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE" contains information on how to inject PrSimlandi™.

PrSimlandi™ Single-Use Prefilled Syringe



Important Information You Need to Know Before Injecting PrSimlandi™

Important Information:

- For subcutaneous injection only.
- **Do not** use the syringe and call your healthcare provider or pharmacist if:
 - · Liquid is cloudy, discolored, or has flakes or particles in it
 - Expiration date has passed
 - Liquid has been frozen (even if thawed) or left in direct sunlight
 - The prefilled syringe has been dropped or crushed
- Keep the needle cover on until right before injection. Keep PrSimlandi™ out of reach of children.
- See the Storage Information section at the end of these instructions for how to store PrSimlandi™.
- Read these instructions for use before using the PrSimlandi™single-use prefilled syringe.

Your healthcare provider should show you how to use PrSimlandi™ before you use it for the first time. Call your healthcare provider or 1 866-399-9091 #2 if you need help.

Current Adalimumab Syringe Users (e.g., Humira®):

Even if you have used the Humira® (adalimumab) syringe in the past, or other syringes on the market, please read the instructions completely so that you understand how to properly use this device before attempting to inject.

Preparing to Inject ^{Pr}Simlandi™

► **STEP 1** Take Syringe Out of Refrigerator and Warm to **Room Temperature for 15-30 Minutes**

- **1.1** Take ^{Pr}Simlandi[™]out of the refrigerator (see Figure A). **1.2** Leave PrSimlandi™at room temperature for 15 to 30 minutes before injecting (see Figure B).
 - Do not remove the gray needle cover while allowing ^{Pr}Simlandi[™] to reach room temperature.
 - **Do not** warm ^{Pr}Simlandi[™]in any other way. For example, do not warm it in a microwave or in hot
 - **Do not** use the prefilled syringe if liquid has been frozen (even if thawed).

2.1 Check expiration date on the prefilled syringe label (see Figure C).

- **Do not** use the prefilled syringe if expiration date has
- **2.2** Check the liquid drug in the syringe to ensure it is clear and colorless (Figure C).
- **Do not** use the syringe and call your healthcare provider or pharmacist if: Liquid is cloudy, discolored, or has flakes or particles in it.






► **STEP 3** Gather Supplies and Wash Hands

- **3.1** Place the following on a clean, flat surface (see Figure D):
- 1 single-use prefilled syringe and alcohol swab
- 1 cotton ball or gauze pad (not included) Puncture-resistant sharps disposal
- container (not included). See Step 9.

Injecting PrSimlandi™

► STEP 4 Choose and Clean Injection Site

- **4.1** Choose an injection site (see Figure F):
- On the front of your thighs or
- Your abdomen (belly) at least 2 inches from your navel (belly button).
- Different from your last injection site (at least one inch from last injection site).
- **4.2** Wipe the injection site in a circular motion with the alcohol swab (see Figure G).
 - **Do not** inject through clothes.
 - Do not inject into skin that is sore, bruised, red, hard, scarred, has stretch marks, or areas with psoriasis.



► STEP 5 Remove Needle Cover

- **5.1** Hold the prefilled syringe in one hand (see Figure H).
- **5.2** Gently pull the needle covers straight off with the other hand (see Figure H).
- Throw the needle cover away.
- Do not recap.
- **Do not** touch the needle with your fingers or let the needle touch anything.
- · You may see a drop of liquid at the end of the needle. This is normal. Figure F




► **STEP 6** Grasp the Syringe and Pinch the Skin

6.1 Hold the body of the prefilled syringe in one hand between the thumb and index fingers, lide a pencil (see Figure I). Do not pull back on the plunger at any time.

6.2 Gently squeeze (pinch) the area of cleaned skin at your injection site with your other hand (see Figure J). Hold the skin firmly.



► STEP 7 Inject the Drug

- **7.1** Insert the needle into the pinched skin at about a 45-degree angle using a quick, dart-like motion (see Figure K).
- After the needle is in, let go of the skin.
- **7.2** Slowly push the plunger all the way in until all of the liquid is injected, and the prefilled syringe is empty (see Figure L).






► **STEP 8** Allow Prefilled Syringe To Retract Needle from Skin

- **8.1** Slowly lift your finger from the plunger. the plunger will move up with your finger and retract the needle from the site, into the needle guard (see Figure M).
 - The needle will not be retracted unless all the liquid is injected. Speak to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse if you think you have not given a full dose.
 - It is normal to see a spring around the plunger rod after the needle is retracted.
- **8.2** After completing the injection, place a cotton ball or gauze pad on the skin of the
- Do not rub.
- Slight bleeding at the injection site is normal.



Disposing of PrSimlandi™

► STEP 9 Dispose Used Syringe into a biohazard safe container

- **9.1** Put your used needles, syringes, and sharps in a biohazard safe container right away after use (see Figure N).
 - Do not throw away (dispose of) loose needles and syringes in the household trash.
- **9.2** The needle cover, alcohol swab, cotton ball or gauze pad, and packaging may be placed in your household trash.



Additional Disposal Information

You may use a household container that is:

- made of a heavy-duty plastic,
- · upright and stable during use,
- · leak-resistant, and
- properly labeled to warn of hazardous waste inside the container.

When your sharps disposal container is almost full, you will need to follow your community guidelines for the right way to dispose of your sharps disposal container.

- **Do not** dispose of your used sharps disposal container in your household trash.
- **Do not** recycle your used sharps disposal container.

Storing PrSimlandi™

- Store PrSimlandi™ in the refrigerator between 2°C to 8°C (36°F to 46°F). Store PrSimlandi™ in the original carton until use to protect it from light.
 - **Do not** freeze ^{Pr}Simlandi[™]. **Do not** use simalndi if frozen, even if it has been thawed. • Refrigerated PrSimlandi™ may be used until the expiration date printed on the PrSimlandi™ carton,
- dose tray or prefilled syringe. **Do not** use ^{Pr}Simlandi[™] after the expiration date. • If needed, for example when you are traveling, you may also store PrSimlandi™ at room temperature up
- to 77°F (25°C) for up to **14** days. Store PrSimlandi™in the original carton until use to protect it from light. • Throw away ^{Pr}Simlandi™if it has been kept at room temperature and not been used within 14 days. • Record the date you first remove PrSimlandi™ from the refrigerator in the spaces provided on the
- carton and dose tray. • **Do not** store ^{Pr}Simlandi[™] in extreme heat or cold.
- **Do not** use a prefilled syring if the liquid is cloudy, discolored, or has flakes or particles in it.
- **Do not** drop or crush ^{Pr}Simlandi™. The prefilled syringe is glass.
- Keep ^{Pr}Simlandi[™], injection supplies, and all other medicines out of the reach of children.
